Weekly Verbal and Non-Verbal, Reasoning skills development.</p> <p><b>Comprehension:</b> Understanding a variety of texts by participating in discussions and asking questions. Students make basic predictions based on details stated and implied.</p> <p><b>Grammar:</b> Use the form of 'a' or 'an', show knowledge of words families, knowledge of adverbs and adjectives. Use speech marks correctly when writing dialogue.</p> <p><b>Writing:</b> Composing and rehearsing sentences orally. Use a variety of conjunctions in sentences and start to build a varied vocabulary. Self assess own writing and make suggestions for improvements. Written addition and subtraction HTU +/- HTU.
